N.B. – Both men & women are eligible to apply for the post.

Duties attached to the post of PARIBESH BANDHU:-

Public Toilets maintained by KMC are generally being cleaned by Paribesh Bandhu under SWM-1 department of Kolkata Municipal Corporation. They will clean the animal wastes from the lanes, roads and streets etc.

Uploading of documents and Certificate: Document regarding Proof of Identity, Caste, Ex-Serviceman, certificate must be scanned and uploaded along with online application. Certificates must be gained within the closing date of Advertisement or before.

Submission of Bond:

Candidates called for personality Test/ Interview will have to submit a Bond on Rs. 50/- Stamp Paper to the effect that they will arrange for temporary lodging / Shelter for doing emergency duties as and when may be required by the Kolkata Municipal Corporation Authorities.

Age Relaxation: The upper age-limit shall be relax able for Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes candidates of West Bengal, by 5 years and by 3 years for Other Backward Classes (OBC-A & OBC-B) candidates. In the case of Persons with Disabilities of 40%, the upper age-limit shall be relax able up to 45 years. Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes & Other Backward Classes candidates of other States shall be treated as General Candidates.

An ex-serviceman shall be allowed to deduct the period of actual military service from his/her actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post of Paribesh Bandhu by more than three years he/she shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding age limit.

Ex- Serviceman eligibility for the post of PARIBESH BANDHU under Ex- Serviceman quota

Ex-Serviceman is a person who has served in any rank whether as combatant or non- combatant in a Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union and

- (i) Who retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or
- (ii) Who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
- (iii) Who has been released, otherwise than on his/her own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment; or
- (iv) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagements, otherwise than at his/her own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency, and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories, namely:
 - (a) Pension holders for continuous embodied service
 - (b) Persons with disability attributable to military service; and
 - (c) Gallantry award winners.

Method of Recruitment:

A. Mode of Examination:

The Examination will be held in two successive stages, viz. (1) Read & Write ability test (2) Field Test, as detailed below:

Read & Write ability Test:

The candidates have to qualify in read & write ability test. They will require to fill up one prescribed format provided by the Commission in his/her own hand writing.

Field Test: (Time based)

Candidates have to appear in a Field Test at a given site for clean public toilets and different sorts of animal wastes manually using brush / toilet cleaner and/ or other appropriate tools.

Panel will be prepared on the basis of performance in the Field Test subject to their qualifying in the Read & Write ability test.

Application Fee: (Non-Refundable)

- 1) Application fee for U.R. & O.B.C. (A & B) candidates are Rs. 150=00 (Rupees One hundred and fifty) plus Processing Charges Rs. 50=00 (Rupees Fifty) by On-line payment.
- 2) For S.C., S.T. & P.H. candidates only Processing Charges Rs. 50=00 (Rupees Fifty) by On-line payment.
- 3) The application fees plus processing charges as mentioned in Para's (1) and (2) above shall be collected by On-line payment method only through Indiaideas.com Limited (Bill Desk) as mentioned at our website www.mscwb.org.

Miscellaneous: A candidate now in service under Central or the State Government / Semi Government / Local / Statutory Body shall have to ensure that No-Objection Certificate (N.O.C.) from his / her present Employer reaches the Office of the West Bengal Municipal Service Commission within 7 (Seven) days preceding the date of Read & Write ability Test. Otherwise, he / she will not be considered for eligible for the Read & Write ability Test. If at any stage a candidate is found ineligible for admission in terms of condition of eligibility for this Examination, his / her candidature will be rejected without further reference to him / her.

Last Date: Last date for Registration for on-line application and the process of submission of Application must be completed by 24/04/2022.
